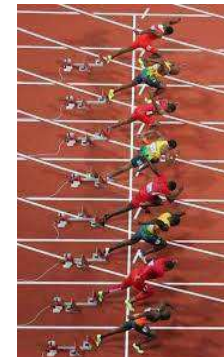

Negotiating private commercial settlements

Our team regularly advises clients on commercial agreements and out-of-court settlement negotiations to achieve their commercial goals.

Merger control is a key factor in the success of M&A deals.

We have acted in prominent and complex merger control matters (Phase I and Phase II cases, requiring corrective measures), both a national and EU level, enabling us to provide strategic advice and recommend appropriate tactics.

A company which receives support from national public authorities in any form whatsoever on a selective basis gains an advantage over its competitors and might be deemed to distort the market and affect trade between Member States. This is why the EU forbids State Aid unless is justified by reasons of general economic development.
